

Photocopying

SIR . . . J.D. St Aubyn (*Nature* 304, 678; 1983) correctly stresses that it is publishers and not authors who are concerned about large-scale copying. In fact most reputable suppliers of tear sheets or photocopies, ourselves included, adhere to the requirements of the Copyright Clearance Center (CCC), so eliminating most of the administrative copying.

The price of an authorized photocopy includes the CCC payment, I believe the British Lending Library has agreed to pay CCC fees on all photocopies mailed to the United States.
