

University City Offers Variety at Lunchtime

A lot of you have probably been wondering where we can go for lunch once we move to University City. After all, lunch is the most important meal of the business day, so ISI employees are understandably curious as to what effect our move will have on this mid-day break. You won't be disappointed either. There are at least two dozen lunch spots within a five-minute walk of our new building. They feature any food you can name — from pizza and steak to burgers and omelets.

Light Lunch at ISI

If you want a light lunch, soup and a sandwich perhaps, you won't even have to leave ISI to get it. Centrally located on the second floor of our new building will be vending machines serving these items as well as ice cream, juice, soda, hot drinks, candy, and pastry. Machines with soda, hot drinks, candy, and pastry will also be located on the first and third floors. All of the vending machines are in employee lounges, outfitted with tables and chairs. So whether you use the machines, brown-bag it, or go out to buy food and bring it back, you can enjoy lunch in a comfortable surrounding, away from your desk.

Gourmet Food Trucks

For those of you who do want to venture out of the building at lunch and bring back food, you can sample a variety of foods from the trucks that frequent the University City area. Typically these are converted trucks, vans, or buses which provide hot or cold sandwiches, hoagies, franks, burgers, pizza, drinks, or snack foods. However, other food trucks are more specialized, featuring gournet food, eggrolls, or prime roast beef. Prices depend on what you buy, of course, but typical prices are included in the listing.

34th and Market

The food truck that stops closest to our building carries a variety of sandwiches, both hot and cold, for lunch. It's usually there from about 11:30a.m. to 1:30p.m. or so. In the morning from 8:00a.m. to 11:00a.m., the truck features prepared breakfast foods, including fried egg sandwiches. Prices range from \$1.25 to \$2.50 for sandwiches.

32nd between Market and Ludlow

34th and Sansom

Hotdog Stands are Plentiful

Those of you who have frequented the "umbrella room" on the corner of Fourth and Chestnut will be happy to know that lunch carts are plentiful in University City. The carts serve hotdogs, sausage, soft pretzels, sodas, and chips. They do business Monday through Friday, from 10:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. on the following corners:

Their prices vary from about 60¢ to \$1.00 for sandwiches. The vendor at 34th and Market has a specialty, our construction people have already found out. He sells sausage on a hard roll as opposed to the soft rolls most of the vendors use.

Relaxed Meals

For a more relaxed lunch you could go out to one of several dining spots within walking distance of ISI. These include fast-food chains, cafeterias, restaurants, bar/grilles, delicatessens, pizza parlors, salad bars, and places featuring international cuisine. Cross-Town Express has compiled a list of many of these eating-places. Some even offer call-in service if you want to pick up lunch to take out. We warn you, the list is probably not comprehensive and we're not recommending any of the dining spots listed. These places have been selected because they are within easy walking distance of ISI and because you can probably eat there within the time allotted for lunch. Some of the places serve the same "lunch-type" food all the time so we have given their business hours in full. Others serve luncheon fare at lunch prices only during certain hours. For them, we have listed the time when you can order from the lunch menu. As you can see, we have a lot to look forward to when we move to University City.
